

Town Office Reopening Health and Safety Protocols due to COVID-19

The intention of this protocol is to protect the health of Town Office staff and patrons, while at the same time maintaining, to the greatest extent possible, the necessary services provided by the Town Clerk/Tax Collector and Administrative Assistant.

Drop-box and Curbside service is still available to anyone who feels uncomfortable entering the office. Please call the Town Clerk/Tax Collector at 847-9043 or the Administrative Assistant at 847-0047.


We cannot at this time legally require staff or patrons to be vaccinated against the Covid-19 virus, nor inquire about anyone's vaccination status or plans. Therefore, for the duration of the pandemic, the Town Office will allow one person to be served at the interior window and will allow one person to wait for service in the entrance lobby. All will be required to use a face mask, hand sanitizer, and practice social distancing while in the office building, regardless of whether they have been vaccinated or not.

We hope that everyone will do their part to keep our community safe and we strongly encourage vaccination for those who are able to do it.

If you have a cough, fever, or any other symptoms of the Covid-19 virus, or have been exposed in the last ten days to anyone who has tested positive for the virus, please do not enter the Town Office. Please call the numbers above to arrange for curbside service.

This protocol will be reviewed at each Select Board meeting until objective public-health sources consider the pandemic to have subsided. The decision to fully reopen the Town Office and other Town Buildings will be made by the Selectmen following review of all available information and in accordance with scientific data and continued safety precautions.


