

Public Notice

Town of Nelson, NH

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held in accordance with RSA 33:8-a on **Thursday January 30, 2020 at 7:00 PM in the Nelson Town Hall** by order of the Nelson Select Board.

The purpose of the hearing is to give notice to the public of a 2020 Warrant Article that, if passed, would require commitment of a Bond or note that would exceed \$100,000. The article: To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$313,747 for the purpose of purchasing a new 2020 John Deere 672G Motor Grader. \$18,000 in offsetting funds to come from trade-in value of the Town Owned 1983 672B Motor Grader, and further to authorize the withdrawal of up to \$110,747 from the Road Equipment Capital Reserve Fund created for that purpose, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$185,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the municipal officials to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon. (Two thirds secret ballot vote required). All persons interested in the proposed action and wishing to be heard concerning the matter will be recognized at the above place and time.

Immediately following the Public Hearing on the Bond article, an informational presentation and discussion will begin on 2020 Warrant Articles for the purchase and installation of a Solar Array to provide the energy needed to power Town buildings and Air-Sourced heat pump systems.
